WHAT SHOULD ACCOMPANY MY CHILD TO SCHOOL EVERY DAY

1. a 10am morning snack (sandwich and 2 or more lighter nibbles / sides, accompanied by a sealable bottle filled with your choice of beverage) STRICTLY no straws or sachets, no fizzy drinks, sweet treats or crisps
2. a full set of extra warm and cool clothes, including a beanie and a sun hat
3. sports bag and appropriate attire for aftercare or sport specific extra murals and activities
4. necessary workbooks, textbooks according to timetable and completed and signed homework book

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

1. our Menu cannot be adjusted or altered, we are unable to accommodate personal, dietary preferences, requests, religious exclusions, or allergens, should our Menu not be suitable, kindly be prepared to supply all meals and snacks throughout the entire day (refer to our **NUTRITION POLICY**)
2. applying sunscreen remains the parents / guardians responsibility, we insist that the lotion be applied before arriving at school on all exposed areas, full day students are to provide a sun lotion, that will remain at school, reapplication will be encouraged after midday
3. **TIMES:** We open promptly at 7am, academics commence strictly at 7:45am – 2pm and 1:30pm on Fridays (avoid unnecessary absenteeism, doctors note required, kindly arrive promptly for school and avoid early collection)
4. **ASSESSMENTS:** During exam and cycle periods school will end at 12pm, from 12-2pm academic support will be offered (ensure to utilise this service)
5. strictly no cellular phones, electronic devices, toys or valuables should accompany your child to school on any given day
6. all belongings should be clearly labelled (toiletries, consumables, uniform, sports and physical education attire, shoes, socks and stationery) we will not be held responsible for any damaged, lost, or misplaced personal items
7. important newsletters, upcoming events, homework, class tests and messages from your Teacher will be sent home occasionally, please be diligent to check diaries and WhatsApp groups for reminders (kindly return their homework books signed and completed daily)
8. **MEDICATION:** no oral medication will be administered to a child, unless a doctor has confirmed chronic, all medication must be signed in at the office, no medication of any kind should be left in a child's bag, assure to collect medication at collection time (refer to our **HEALTH POLICY**)
9. **UNIFORMS:** Uniforms are compulsory, unless otherwise communicated for uniform free days (refer to our **UNIFORM POLICY**)
10. **BOOKS:** Front cover pages are provided for all workbooks and will be sent home within the first week of Term 1, kindly cover all books and textbooks with heavy duty 130-micron plastic as well as a supportive board for the soft cover textbooks
11. **MONDAYS - FRIDAY:** Tuck Shop (kindly send cash in a labelled holder, students will be responsible for the safekeeping of their own money)
12. **FRIDAYS:** Market Day – items sold at R5 each
13. **COMMUNICATION:** parents are requested to utilize our WhatsApp number for daily requests and instructions (072 101 8282) in more serious instances, please arrange a meeting with the relevant Teachers/Heads in the afternoons. Personal messages directly to the Teachers cellular number is not permitted. You may utilize their homework diaries/books for correspondence between Parent and Teacher
