### IMPORTANT REMINDERS

6. all belongings should be clearly labelled (toiletries, consumables, uniform, sports and physical education attire, shoes, socks and stationery) we will not be held responsible for any damaged, lost, or misplaced personal items
7. important newsletters, upcoming events, homework, class tests and messages from your Teacher will be sent home occasionally, please be diligent to check diaries and WhatsApp groups for reminders
8. **MEDICATION:** all medication must be signed in at the office, no medication of any kind should be left in a child's bag, it will remain the students responsibility to report to the office to administer their meds as well as collect at home time (refer to our **HEALTH POLICY**)
9. **UNIFORMS:** Uniforms are compulsory, unless otherwise communicated for uniform free days (refer to our **UNIFORM POLICY**)
10. **BOOKS:** Front cover pages are provided for all workbooks and will be sent home within the first week of Term 1, kindly cover all books and textbooks with heavy duty 130-micron plastic as well as a supportive board for the soft cover textbooks

12. **FRIDAYS:** Market Day – items sold at R5 each
