Denim library book bag with handle (trefoil)

2 x Cans of shaving foam 200ml

A4 25 Butterfly project board 160g (bright)

Glue stick 40g (pritt)

4 x 100g Tubs finger paint

1 x pack of rice, pasta, cereal and jelly

20 x various size recycled plastic tubs with lids (e.g. 1kg yogurt tub)

Preloved telephones, keyboards (items with push-buttons)

Liquid glue 120ml (ponal)

1 x Flip File A4 50 pocket (Kangaroo)

A4 50 Butterfly board 160g (white)

4 x 100 pack Surgical gloves (powder free)

Chunky jumbo knob puzzle (3 pcs.)

Plastic stacking cups (coloured 6-piece)

20 x Recycled coloured plastic bottle caps

Recycled medication/tablet bottles (plastic with lids)

* Items highlighted in orange are not included in the prepacked boxes from Diskonto. Parents can either buy these items separately or request it be added when ordering their age specific box (the reason for this is some items can be purchased cheaper elsewhere or be reused from the year before.)

WHAT SHOULD ACCOMPANY MY CHILD TO SCHOOL EVERY DAY

1. Minimum of 6 nappies, wet wipes, nappy bags as well powder or bum cream
2. **ALL** daily meals, snacks and including formula, juice or water bottles to be supplied daily (bottles must be premade and measured at home, we will add the water to formula bottles), until such time your child has been introduced to solids and are able to consume our current menu. Parents will be expected to confirm in writing their child's readiness and any known allergies when transitioning to our menu (refer to our **NUTRITION POLICY**)
3. We strongly encourage the weaning of dummies / soothers and bottles sooner than later, to minimize spread of germs
4. A 10am morning snack (sandwich and 2 or more lighter nibbles / sides, accompanied by a sealable bottle filled with your choice of beverage) Strictly no straws or sachets, no fizzy drinks, sweet treats or crisps
5. A full 2 sets of extra warm and cool clothes, beanie and a sun hat
6. Minimum of 6 feeding bibs and 4 dribble bibs for between feeds
7. Pillow and pillowcase, and 1 warm blanket and 2 wrapping blankets (will be sent home when soiled, kindly replace the next attending school day)

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

1. Our Menu cannot be adjusted or altered, we are unable to accommodate personal, dietary preferences, requests, religious exclusions, or allergens, should our Menu not be suitable, kindly be prepared to supply all meals and snacks throughout the entire day (refer to our **NUTRITION POLICY**)
2. Avoid dressing your child in expensive, branded, or sentimental clothing
3. Applying sunscreen remains the parents / guardians responsibility, we insist that the lotion be applied before arriving at school on all exposed areas, full day students are to provide a clearly labelled sun lotion, that will remain at school, which will be used for reapplication after midday
4. **TIMES:** We open @7am, academics commence STRICTLY at **8am – 1:30pm**, further refer to COLLECTION PROCEDURE, explained in the FEE POLICY (kindly arrive promptly for school and avoid early collection to cause minimum disruption)
5. **BREAKFAST:** is served between **7:30 - 8am** (students who arrive after the designated time will not be served breakfast)
6. Strictly no toys or valuables should accompany your child to school
7. All belongings should be clearly labelled (toiletries, consumables, clothing, shoes, socks and bedding, covers and inners) we will not be held responsible for any damaged, lost, or misplaced personal items
8. Important newsletters, upcoming events, invites and artwork will be sent home on occasion, please be diligent to check your child's library book bag, d6 and the class whatsapp group (kindly return their library book bag the next attending school day)
9. **MEDICATION:** no oral medication will be administered to a child, unless a doctor has confirmed chronic, all medication must be signed in at the office, no medication of any kind should be left in a child's bag, assure to collect medication at collection time (refer to our **HEALTH POLICY**)
10. **BOOKS:** Kindly cover all books with heavy duty 130-micron plastic as well as a supportive board for the outer soft cover
11. **COMMUNICATION:** parents are requested to utilise our office WhatsApp number for daily requests and instructions (072 101 8282) in more serious instances please refer to our COMMUNICATION & GRIEVANCE PROCEDURE. Messages directly to staff's cellular number is not **PERMITTED**
